NOTICE INVITING TENDER

The Superintending Archaeologist, Archaeological Survey of India, Hyderabad Circle, 2nd Block, 3rd Floor, Kendriya Sadan, Sultan Bazar, Hyderabad on behalf of President of India, invites tender in sealed cover for supply and fabrication of architectural members in granite stone from approved and qualified Class-I Stapati, who are registered with the Archaeological Survey of India, Government of Andhra Pradesh, Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams and/or similar departments who are involved in conservation and reconstruction of temples. The Stapati should have executed at least two major works of fabrication and erection of Hindu temples. Tenders will be received on 11-01-2012 up to 3.00 p.m. and will be opened in the office of the Superintending Archaeologist, Archaeological Survey of India, Hyderabad circle, Hyderabad on the same day at 3.30 P.M. The details of work and tender documents will be available with the cash section in the office of the Superintending Archaeologist, Archaeological Survey of India, Hyderabad Circle, Hyderabad and in the office of the Conservation Assistant, Archaeological Survey of India, Warangal on all working days between 11.00 AM to 4.00 PM.

The tender forms of vendor/bidder who do not deposit earnest money in the prescribed form will be summarily rejected. The sealed cover should be superscribed with the name of work & date of opening

Note:

- 1) Last date of issue of tender documents is : 09-01-2012
- 2) Work should start immediately soon after issue of work/supply order and shall complete within 120 days from the said date according to specifications and specific directions/instructions of the under signed time to time.
- 3) The Contractor/supplier will be permitted to attend at the time tender opening.
- 4) The tender documents are available on website WWW.asi.nic.in which may be down loaded and submitted along with the tender form cost in the form of DD in favour of Superintending Archaeologist, Archaeological Survey of India, Hyderabad Circle, Hyderabad. The DD towards the VAT should be favoring the Commercial Tax Officer, CTO, Sultan Bazar Hyderabad.
- 5) In respect of the downloaded tender schedules from Archaeological Survey of India website, the demand drafts towards cost of Tender and the VAT applicable on the cost of tenders should be purchased on or before the last date for sale of tenders i.e. 09-01-2012
- 6) Three separate DD's to be submitted to towards the cost of Tender, EMD and VAT by those who have down loaded tender schedules from the web site.
- 7) Tender schedule should be duly signed by the contractor with his full name and address, must be attested by the witness. The envelop should be sealed and super scribed the name of the work and the date of tender opening.
- 8) If the date of issue/receipt of the tender happens to be holiday, the tenders will be issued/opened on the next working day.
- 9) The Contractor's Registration Certificate, Industry Registration Certificate, Income tax Clearance Certificate, VAT, and Residence Proof Certificate, experience certificate and details of major works done recently are to be submitted along with the tender schedule invariably. Rebate or discount if any should be mentioned below the grand total of the schedule and the amount should also be written in words.

- 1) The Contractor/supplier /Stapati should inspect the stakyard which is opposite to the Padmakshi temple, Hanumakonda Warangal Dist, Warangal to observe the columns, beams and brackets since similar members have to be fabricated.
- 2) The approved Stapati/ Contractor/Supplier shall initially submit a sample of granite stone for approval by the National Institute of Technology, Warangal in order to verify whether the stone matches exactly in all respects to the granite stone which was used for the Kalyanamandapa
- 3) The dimensions of all the architectural members are not similar and hence the Contractor/supplier has to check with the drawing while fabricating each architectural member. Stone's containing veins; cortex or weathered surface will be summarily rejected.
- 4) The contractor/supplier/ Stapatis have to undertake minor works if any pertaining to fabricated architectural members during erection. Whereas 50% of the contractual amount will be paid on delivery of the fabricated members and the remaining 50% will be paid after erection of the architectural members.
- 5) The price quoted by the Contractor/Supplier/Stapati should include transportation charges from the quarry to the place of fabrication work and to the transport to the Thousand Pillared Temple complex or elsewhere nearby. The payment will be made for the fully fabricated architectural members only. Any kind of losses or damages during the fabrication shall be borne by the contractor/supplier/stapati exclusively.
- 6) The undersigned reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason.
- 7) For all disputes arising out of the tenders, D.G., ASI, New Delhi is the final authority for arbitration.
- 8) The Contractor/Supplier/Stapati shall ensure that he should always concentrate for progress of the work with the approbation of the under signed and must be cooperative with the A.S.I. Technical officials for completion of the work without delay.
- 9) The Contractor/Supplier/Stapati should not assign the work to sub contracot/s without written consent of the under signed.
- 10) The Contractor/Supplier/Stapati happens to face any practical difficulties while execting the contractual work, he is at liberty to seek help/guidance of the undersigned and old monuments should not be spoiled while executing the work.
- 11) The Contractor/Supplier/Stapati should engage skilled and experienced work men to execute the work promptly and to complete in the prescribed time limit.
- 12) The approved Stapati/Contractor/Supplier shall submit a sample granite stone along with test certificate from the National Institute of Technology, Warangal so as to match the stone with that of the granite stone which was used for the Kalyanamandapa of T.P.Temple.
