1. Tenders are hereby invited on behalf of the President of India for supply of materials Brick Aggregate (20mm size), highyield strength deformed bars, M.S. Grill (as per design) etc. Estimate Cost of Rs. 6,22,140/- only.
2. Contract Documents consisting of the detailed plans, complete specifications, the schedule of quantities of the various clauses of work to be done, and the set of conditions of contract to be complied with by the person whose tenders may be accepted, which will also be bound printed in the form of tenders can be seen purchased at the Divisional/Sub-Divisional Office between the hours 11.00 A.M. to 3.00 P.M. every day, except on Sunday & Public holidays.
2. (A) The Site for the work is available or the site for the work shall be made available in parts as specified below.
3. Tenders, which should always be placed in sealed cover with the name of the work written on the envelopes receive the Divisional/Sub-Divisional Officer Guwahati Circle office. Division/Sub-Division up to 30.08.2010 and will be opened by him in his office on the same day at 3.00 P.M.
4. Tenders are to be on P.W.D. form No. 9 (Nine) Which can be obtained from the office of the Divisional/Sub-Divisional Officer concerned on payment of sum of Rs. 500/-in cash. The time allowed for the carrying out of the work will be from the fifteenth day after the date of written orders to commence work.
5. The Contractors should quote in figures as well as in words the rate and amount tendered by him/them. The amount for each item should be worked out and the requisite totals given.
6. When a Contractor signs a tender in an Indian Language the percentage above or below and the tendered amount in the case of C.P.W.D. from No. 7 and the total amount tendered in the case of C.P.W.D. from Nos. 8 and 12, should also be written in the same language, in the case of illiterate contractors the rates of the amounts tendered should be attested by a witness.
7. Issue of tender form will be stopped two days before the date of opening of tenders.
8. Earnest Money amounting to Rs. 15,554/-(unless exempted) in Received Treasury Challan/Deposit al Call Receipt on a Schedule Bank Guaranteed by the Reserve Bank of India must accompany each tender and cast tender is to be in a sealed cover superscribed Tender for and addressed to the divisional/Sub-Division al Officer Division/Sub-Division.
9. The Contractor whose tender is accepted, (unless exempted) will be required to furnish by way of security deposit for the due fulfillment of his contract such sum as will amount.
 - (i) In the case of works costing up to Rs. 1, 00,000/- to 10% of the estimate cost of the work put to tender.
 - (ii) In the case of works costing up to Rs. 1,00,000/- and up to Rs. 2,00,000/- to 10% on the first Rs. 1,00,000/- and 7 1/2% on the balance and
 - (iii) In the care of works costing more than 2,00,000/- to 10% on the first 1,00,000/-, 7 1/2% on the next Rs. 1,00,000/- and 5% on the balance, subject to a maximum of Rs. 1,00,000/-

The security deposit will be collected by deductions from the Running Account Bills of the Contractor at the rates mentioned above and the earnest money if deposited in cash at the time for tenders, will be treated as a part of the Security Deposit. The Security amount will also be accepted in cash or in the shape of Govt. Securities? Fixed Deposit Receipt and Guarantee Bonds of Scheduled Bank and State Bank of India will also be accepted for this purpose provided confirmatory advice is forth coming from the Reserve Bank of India.

10. The acceptance of a Tender, will rest withEngineer, who does not bind himself to accept the lowers tender, and reserves to himself the authority to reject any or all of the tenders received without the assignment of a reason. All tenders in which any of the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled or are incomplete in any respect are liable to be rejected.

11. Canvassing in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.

12. All rates shall be quoted on the proper form of the tender alone.

13. An item-rate tender containing percentage below/above will be summarily rejected. However, where a tender voluntarily offered a rebate for payment within a stipulated period this may be considered.

14. On acceptance of the tender, the name or the accredited representative(s) of the contractor who would be responsible taking instructions from the Engineer –in-charge shall be communicated to the Engineer-in-Charge.

15. Special care should be taken to write the rates in figures as well as in words and the amount in figures only, in such a way that interpolation is not possible. The total amount should be written both in figures and in words. In case of figure or rupees and word “P” after the precede and the figures, ‘e..g.’ Rs. 2.15P and in case of precede. The word ‘rupees’ should precede the word paise should be written at the end. Unless the rate is in whole rupees and followed by the words ‘only’ it should be invariably be up to two decimal places, while quoting the rates in schedule of quantities, the word ‘only’ should be written closely following the amount and it should not be written in the next line.

16. The President of India does not bind himself to accept the lowest or any tender and reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the tender and the tender shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.

17. Sales Tax and any other tax on materials in respect of this contract shall be payable by the contractor and Govt. will not entertain any claim whatsoever in this respect.

18. The contractor must procure in produce Income Tax Clearance Certificate quoted with the PAN No. before the tender paper sold to him.

19. The Contractor(s) shall not be permitted to tender for works in the **C.P.W.D.** (Circle responsible for award and execution of contracts) in which his near relative is posted as Divisional Accountant or as an Officer in any capacity between the grades Superintending Engineer and Assist. Engineer (both inclusive) We shall also intimate the names of person who are near relative to any Gazetted Officer in the Central Public Works & Housing. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would tender him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of the Department.

20. Contractor shall give a list of non-Gazetted **C.P.W.D.** employees related to him.

21. No Engineer of Gazetted rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department Of the Govt. of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of two years of his retirement from Govt. Service, without the previous permission of the Govt. of India. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found at any time to be such a person who had no

obtained the permission of the Govt. of India as aforesaid before submission of the tender or engagement in the contractor's service.

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22. The tender for works shall remain open for acceptance for a limited period from the date of opening of tenders. If any tenderer withdrew his tender before the said period or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the tender which are not acceptable to the Deptt., then the Govt. shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy be at liberty to forfeit 10% of the said earnest money absolutely.

23. The contractors exempted from payment of earnest Money/Security Deposit in individual cases should attach with the tender an attested copy of the Chief Engineer's letter exempting them from the payment of Earnest Money and security deposit and should produce the original whenever called upon to do so.

24. The tender for the work shall not be witnessed by a contractor or contractors who himself / themselves has / have tendered or who may and has/have tendered for the same work. Failure to observe this condition would render tenders of the contractors tendering as well as witnessing the tender liable to summarily rejection.

25. The tender for the composite work includes the sanitary and water supply installations, Electrical works and Horticulture Work.

26. It will be obligatory on the part of the tenderer to tender and sign the tender documents for all the components parts and that after the work is awarded he will have to enter into an agreement for each component officer concerned viz :-

- (a) Executive Engineer Civil for Civil component.
- (b) Executive Engineer Elect. for Elect. Component.
- (c) Deputy Director of Horticulture for Horticulture component.

27. The tenderer apart from being a Class I (B&R) contractor must associate himself with agencies of the appropriate class which are eligible to tender for (i) Electrical (ii) Sanitary and water Supply installations and (iii) Horticulture.

28. The contractor shall submit list of works which are hand progress in the following form :-
